TINKER FEDERAL CREDIT UNION MOORE BRANCH SUSTAINS TORNADO DAMAGE

OKLAHOMA CITY – The Tinker Federal Credit Union (TFCU) branch located at 400 S.W. 6th Street in Moore sustained considerable damage during the storm on May 20, 2013, and is closed indefinitely.

TFCU employees, following established safety procedures, were safe in the branch's vault during the storm. All branch employees were released unharmed from the vault with the assistance of first responders.

Branch management has confirmed that all personal safe deposit boxes are secure.

In addition to the Moore location, the following TFCU branches are also closed for the remainder of the day: Norman East, Southwest Oklahoma City, Southwest Oklahoma City Drive-thru, Northeast Oklahoma City, Midwest City, Midwest City East, and Tinker Air Force Base branches. All other TFCU facilities are open.

Tinker Federal Credit Union is the largest credit union in Oklahoma, with over \$3 billion in assets and 275,000 members.
