### We have an extra day in February

Ever think it would be nice to have an extra day to spend with family or play with friends? Or maybe even catch up on homework? Well, you're in luck, because 2024 has just that. Most years, February only has 28 days, but every four years, this year is one of those years, is called a leap year. February 2024 has 29 days.

And why is this? The calendar is supposed to match the solar year, in other words, the length of time it takes for Earth to orbit the sun once. But, this doesn't add up to exactly one year, or 365 days. It actually takes Earth 365 days, five hours, 48 minutes and 46 seconds to complete its orbit (about 365 1/4 days). Those extra hours add up and, after four years, the calendar is off by about one day. Adding a day every four years allows the calendar to match up to the solar year again. Those five hours, 48 minutes and 46 seconds don't sound like a lot, but if we didn't adjust for this day every four years, eventually our seasons wouldn't fall in the same months every year. For instance, school might eventually start in the spring instead of late summer. And farmers would have a difficult time growing crops, which could affect food supplies.

So, on February 29, go out and do something fun to celebrate the extra day!

## Sing-a-long!

Thirty days has September, April, June and November. All the rest have 31, Except for February, it's the one, which only has 28 days clear and 29 in a leap year.


